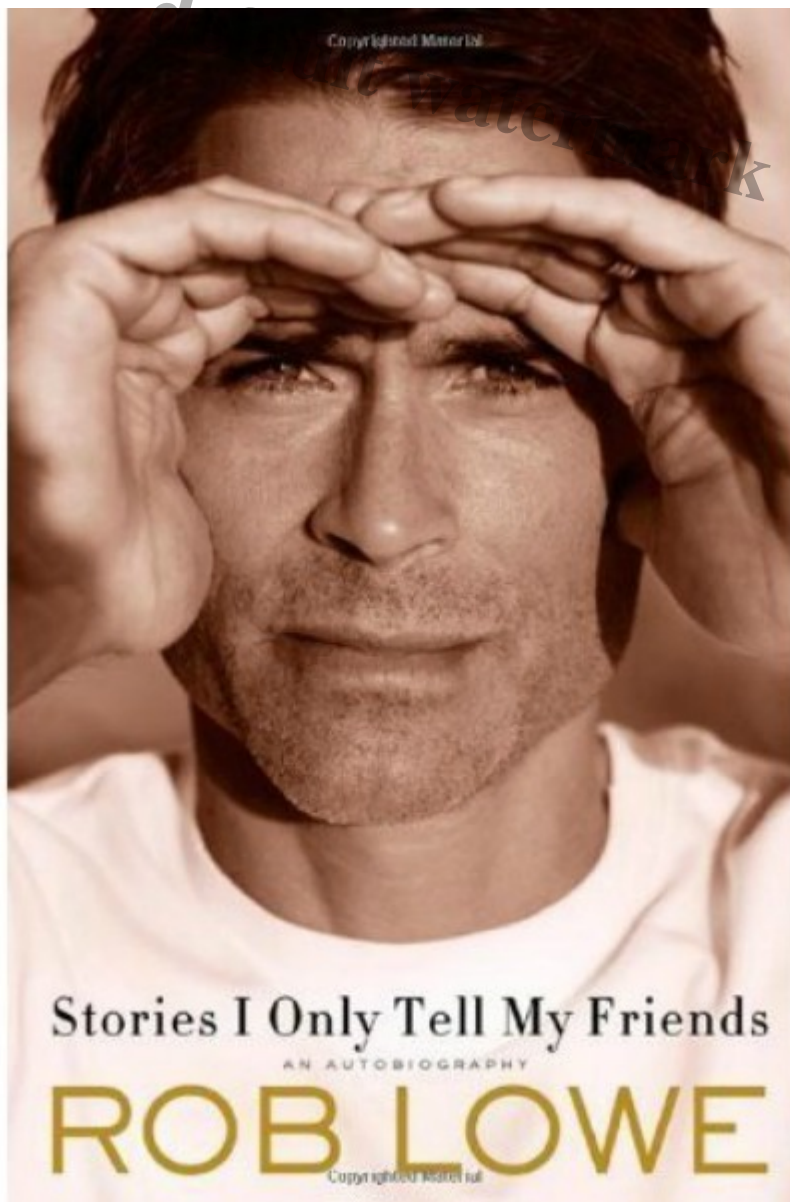


Rob Lowe
