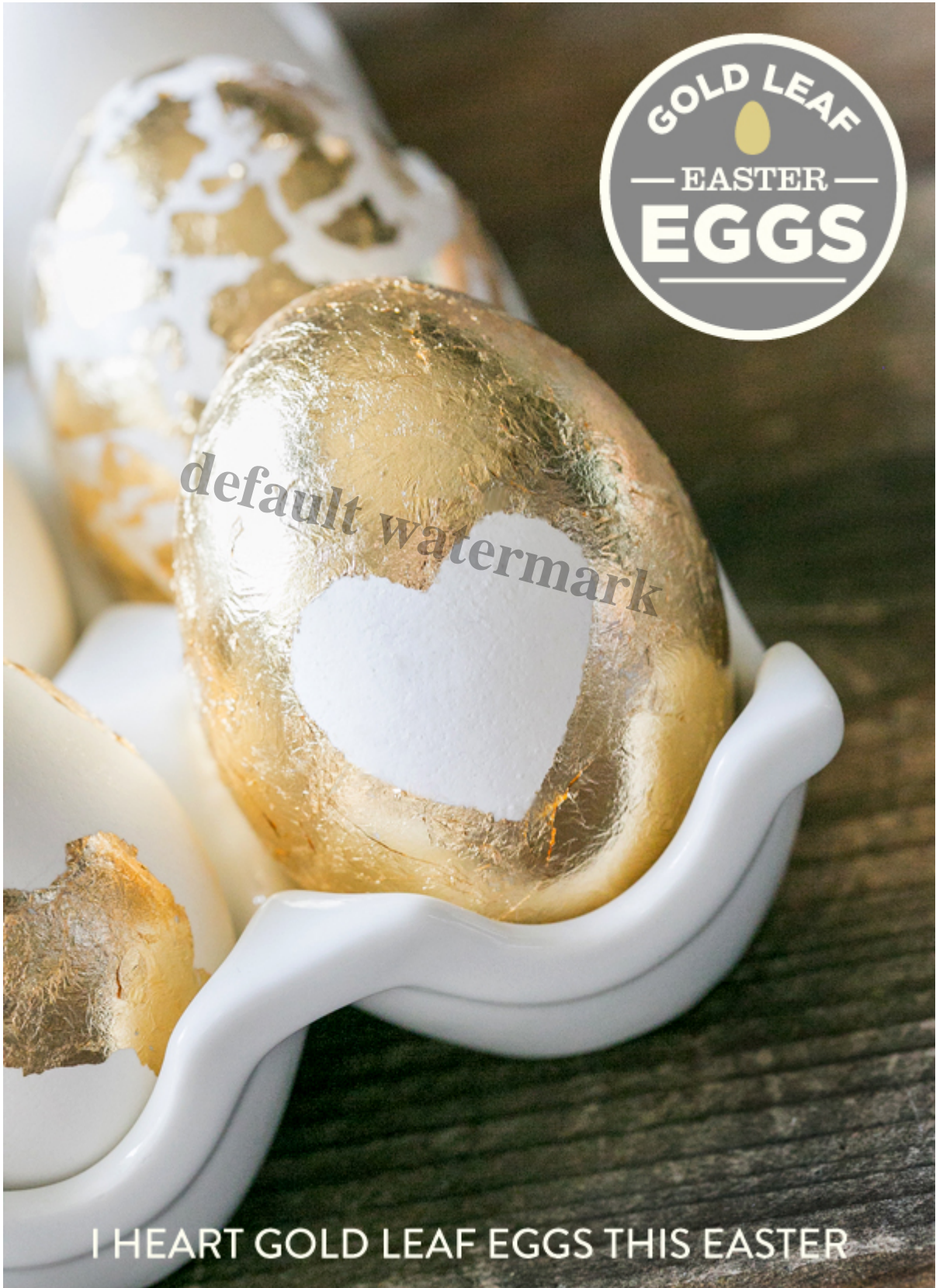




Decorating Easter Eggs
