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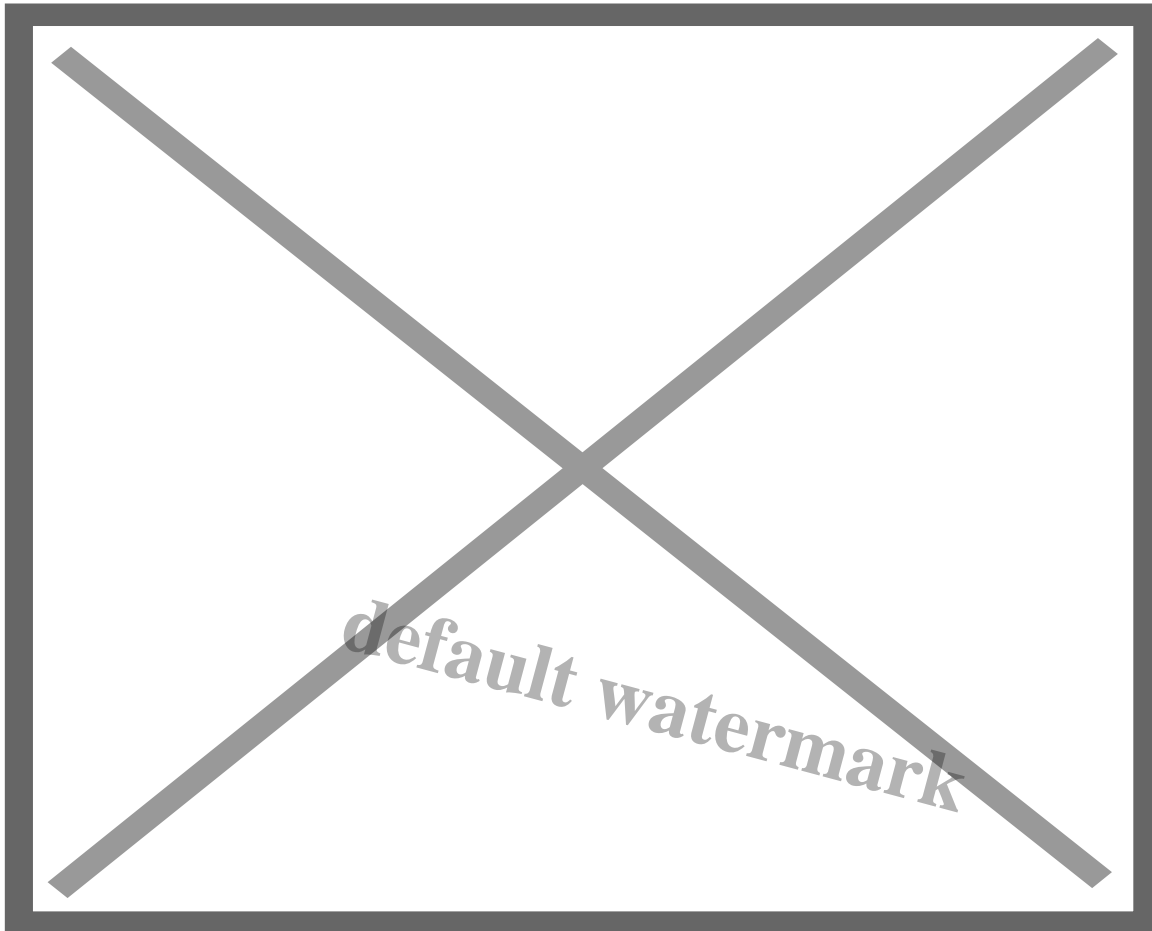

Ingredients

- 1 (15.25 oz) box of spice cake mix
- 1 (15 oz) can of pumpkin (not pie filling)
- 1 bag of chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup of water

Instructions

1. Thoroughly mix spice cake mix, water and pumpkin together.
2. Stir in chocolate chips.
3. Fill muffin tins almost to the top.
4. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes.
