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4. Clean out a drawer and make it pretty inside by using little tea cups to organize your jewelry like [Paige Smith](#). My friend [Cathy](#) loves this idea and has actually done this with one of her drawers.

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5. Light a candle or invest in a scentsy. Whenever my friend Michelle visits she always asks what scent Iâ€™ve got burning. 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6. Decant liquids that you keep sitting out on counters into pretty bottles and corral kitchen items on a tray like [Martha Stewart](#).
