[Martin City Brewery](#) is located in a little brick building next to the railroad tracks. It's not very big, but it has a nice beer garden where you can sit outside during the warmer months. I've only been there a few times, but one of my favorite things on the menu is the fried goat cheese salad.



[Genesse Royale](#) is located in Kansas City, Missouri and is very close to the [West Bottoms](#) . The West Bottoms is a great place to go antiques on the first weekend of every month. The Webster House is located in Kansas City, Missouri and it's right next to the Kauffman Center. It's a great place to have dinner and then watch a performance at the beautiful Kauffman Center. I have eaten there for both lunch and dinner. It also has a nice little gift shop located inside the house. They sell Pickwick candles which are locally made and one of my favorites.



The first time I came across [Chez Elle](#) I thought I was transported to Europe. The building is so different from the others on Summit Street. If you love crepes then this is your place. Another great restaurant

on Summit that I love is West End Local.
